- Funds research
- Advise on research policy development and investments in Greenland

Funding (per year)

- Research promotion grants
1.2 mil. DKK
Deadline: 1 March
- PhD og Postdoc stipends
7.5 mil. DKK
Deadline: 1 October

Funding criteria

Designed to directly encourage projects to:

- Collaborate with stakeholders and local institutions
- Focus on future users and engage in local partnerships
- Engage in formal and informal research training
- Engage and inspire citizens through versatile science outreach



Assessment criteria

- Scientific content and quality, applicant's qualifications.
- Project's realizability
- Methods for inclusion of society
- Methods for science communication
- Economy

Research Promotion Grants

- Apply up to 250.000 DKK:
 - Up to 100.000 kr.: can be 1 institution
 - Up to 250.000 kr.: must be a collaboration between at least 2 institutions.
- May cover salaries, operational costs, costs associated with data collection, travel expenses, costs related to outreach and communication
- Can not cover overhead costs, conference fees, translation or publication costs only, PhD projects, Master's thesis

Send in via online application form together with:

- Project description
- Budget
- CV(s)
- Accept form from administering institution

Project description

- Max. four A4 pages (incl. tables and figures and excl. reference list), each page max. 2.400 characters incl. spaces.
- Purpose, background, project plan, method, timeline, description of (inter)national cooperation, methods for science communication, methods to involve society.

Budget

- Must include all expenses and specify any co-funding and in-kind contributions
- Co-funding must be attested for

CVs

- Max. 2-page CV excl. publication list for applicant
- Max 2-page CVs incl. publication list for any scientific personnel for whom salary is applied for
- Description of all project participants' roles and their affiliation with Greenland institutions

Accept form

- Acceptance and budget confirmation from administering institution must be filled out, signed and enclosed.
- Co-funding and in-kind contributions can be attested in a letter.
